We designed this rider for optimal effectiveness, and if there are any questions or issues with providing anything, please don't hesitate to get in touch with the band manager to find a solution. Any deviation or alteration from the below list of equipment must obtain the band manager's approval. Thank you for your time.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If the provider does not have any of these technical requirements, all other offers must be approved in advance by the band manager.



SOUND & SOUND CHECK

General Information:

- All technical requirements should be completed prior to MVF Band's arrival.
- MVF Band needs two (2) hours minimum for set up and sound check with the crew and sound technician.
- Local crew must be familiar with venue and technical equipment.
- Band requires one (1) hour break between sound check and performance.

Sound System:

- A high quality PA system must be provided that can produce a minimum of 110 db/a, linear and undistorted sound throughout the venue (preferred: Meyer, Nexo or similar)
- FOH desk position has to be in the middle of the venue, NOT in a control booth,
 NOT under a balcony, and NOT close to a wall.
- FOH console must have minimum 24 channels (preferred: Yamaha CL, Midas Pro or similar).

Stage:

Stage area must be completely clean and dry, with a minimum size of 8m x 5m. For stage requirements please see backline and input list.

We need 5 bottles of water on stage during the performance.

Monitors:

The band requires six (6) separated floor monitors (minimum 12") on five (5) auxiliary channels.

Mix 1 - Tar/Vocal

Mix 2 - Sax

Mix 3 - Keys

Mix 4 - Bass

Mix 5 - Drums

Mix 5 has two (2) monitors (see stage plot below).





NOTE: The list does not include any cables, DI boxes or microphone types. Feel free to choose what you feel works best with the sound system.




